MEDIA RELEASE BY YB DATO' SERI KONG CHO HA MENTERI PENGANGKUTAN

ENCOURAGING RESPONSE FOR 'WWW' SERIES REGISTRATION

PUTRAJAYA 11 MAYI 2012 – Dato' Seri Kong Cho Ha reminded those interested in bidding for the WWW series number plates to do it before 12.00 noon, 14th of May 2012.

He added that the bidding process was going smoothly and the response was extremely encouraging. Up until the 10th of May 2012, 14,131 bids for the WWW series number plates were received by the Road Transport Department. The locations and the number of bids received is as per the table below:

He explained that this is the highest number ever recorded by the Road Transport Department. Prior to this, the WVW series number plates raked in 4,750 bidders. This is a tremendous difference of 9,381 compared to the WWW series number plates.

Rumour has it that even unpopular numbers with the WWW series have received high bids. Kong said, in addition all categories: "golden numbers" hot and popular have received many bids and the expected bid amount is rumoured to be very high comparatively. In other words, there is a probability that all numbers ranging from 1 – 9999 have been bid.

The tender for the WWW series number plates was opened on the 30th April 2012 and will end on the 14th of Mei 2012. As of 10th May 2012, the Road Transport Department had received 14,131 bids, 2,000 more bidding receipts are expected to be released on Friday (11th May 2012) and on Monday (14th May 2012). This means that there will be more than 14,131 bidders for the WWW series number plates. The results of the bid will be released on the 24th of May 2012.
